

## HOW ARE RESOURCES FOR ALTCS TREATED?


When applying for ALTCS, countable resources for single applicants, cannot be more than \$2000.

If your resources are over \$2,000, you may still be able to qualify by setting up a special type of trust, please ask for more information.

If you are legally married, you may be able to set aside some of your resources for the needs of your spouse, so long as your spouse is not living in a medical facility. If you are married, please ask for more information.


### COUNTABLE RESOURCES

- Checking, savings, and credit union accounts
- Real property that you do not live in
- Cash value of some life insurance policies
- Cash, stocks, bonds, certificates of deposits
- Non-exempt vehicles



### RESOURCES NOT COUNTED

- Your home that you live in, unless it is held in a trust
- One vehicle
- Burial plots and irrevocable burial plans
- \$1500 designated for burial
- Household and personal belongings
- Certain financial accounts that are excluded by federal law.
